WAVE004000. 'Rude awakening' depicts unique V2 class locomotive 60813 rushing the bank at Newcastleton Station with a Canal Yard to Niddrie Yard fully fitted freight in late summer of 1962. Measurements for frame 485mm x 702mm, image size 336mm x 554mm.

WAVE 004001. V2 class locomotive 60816 setting off from Newcastleton with a class 2 stopping train from Carlisle to Edinburgh, again in 1962. Measurements for frame 505mm x 713mm , image size 355mm x 560mm.
